1. The opening of unconventional children's museum

Good afternoon,

My name is Jinhee Kim, I'm a new director of Korean Gyeonggi Children's Museum.

The Gyeonggi Children's Museum is located in South Korea, Northeast Asia. It is the largest, very first and child-centered museum that situated in Gyeonggi Province.

2. The external appearance of the Gyeonggi Children's Museum

With a total surface area of 10,600m², the Gyeonggi Children's Museum is surrounded by green nature and beautiful mosaic tiles and more than 50 people are working as employees.

Moreover, the children's museum fosters better relations with 2 other museums – Gyeonggi Province Museum and Nam Jun Paik Art Center – in the neighborhood.

3. Increasing numbers of visitors

Although people have to purchase tickets, as many as one hundred thousand people visited the museum in just 45 days after the opening. People thought that the museum could be an exciting place where they could experience the joy of learning.

4. Exhibition composition

The Gyeonggi Children's Museum has 9 galleries related with various themes of environment, cultures, arts, and science and 1 galley for special exhibition. Additionally, the museum displays 10 creative works of art.

5. Works of art

The children's museum displays several beautiful works of art here and there in order to offer opportunities to appreciate the arts. The 'fantastic ocean voyage' is an interactive work of art which dolphins move as they

swim in the sea.

6. Distinctive permanent exhibition

I would like to introduce you an interesting exhibition. Children are able to understand and learn wisdom as a treasure by reading traditional fairy tales in Korea.

7. Distinctive permanent exhibition

This is the biggest climber, '21st century Jack and the Beanstalk.' Children can have the opportunity to challenge themselves and to set their body free so that children reduce their excessive academic stress.

8. Special exhibitions

we held an exhibition based on a theme of a pet. Thereby, the purpose of this section was to help children get better emotional states through learning to take care of others.

Currently, we make an effort to increase the museum's reputation by visiting several local areas with 'traveling exhibitions.'

9. Educational programs

Gyeonggi Children's Museum conducts many different kinds of educational programs by themes, children's age, and seasons. We hold an active art education in 'echo atelier.' supporting by Whaseung city women's business association.

This year's our summer program topic was <Fun Fun Weather>. So we've installed dark cloud that operates with sound of thunder. This installation was sponsored by Lightning Museum and we also made science, culture and art activities.

We've added 10 more exhibits to the gallery that suits the topic of well-being for the human body gallery.

To celebrate the Korea's Elders Day, we opened special exhibition called <My Awesome Grandparents> to help children to understand Korean family culture and connections between 3 generations.

Not only that, we've started school life simulation training program as niche exhibition.

10. next year plan

In next year, we are planning to form a exhibition production team to develop new exhibitions through prototype.

This exhibition is to help children to understand 'Korean wave' more easily through music and culture.

To attract more people to visit these museums, we are planning to set up the new exhibition on the rooftop of Children's Museum as a collaboration with artists.

11. A networking museums - an international seminar

Celebrating one year anniversary, Gyeonggi Children's Museum held an international seminar which provided an opportunity to seek for a future-oriented role and to share an exemplary case of children's museums.

We are planning the second international seminar next year.

12. The 3rd Asian Children's Museum Conference(ACMC)

We held the 3rd Asian Children's Museum Conference in last year.

We invited several guest speakers from Europe, the United States of America, and Asia and shared ideas and exemplary cases regarding exhibitions and education for cultural diversity.

13. The hub of children's museum

two new children's museums are currently under construction in Northern Gyeonggi Province. Moreover, we play a pivotal role in the form of a consultative group with 16 children's museums in Korea.

14. An inventive museum for future generations

Being a representative of Asian children's museums, we will keep trying to become an inventive museum for future generations as we communicate more with others and encourage more participation.
